Recital Information for Parents

- The show will be held at South Whidbey High School Auditorium.
- Pictures will be held at Island Dance May 31st and June 1st. Schedule coming soon.
- Rehearsal will be held at Island Dance June 7th and 8th. Schedule coming soon.
- Parents are still not permitted at the studio during photos and rehearsals. We encourage you to wait for your dancer/gymnast in your car and change them if need be between times.
- Please park in the rear of the building at Island Dance on rehearsal days.
- WIDT company, apprentice, juniors and upper level dancers will dress in the backstage dressing rooms of the auditorium.
- Female adult dancers will dress in the right side turn table room, located near the theater entrance. Men/boys will use the left side turn table room located near the theater entrance. Younger dancers will dress and be held in the commons, located by the front doors.
- Children must be dressed and ready to go, 4 numbers before their piece in the commons (they will be taken backstage and prepare to go onstage by the runners).
- If children are in multiple sections of the recital and need help changing or hair, you can pick up your child and help them change during a break.
- Runners are needed for the recital only and are not needed for dress/rehearsal day.
- Each dancer should bring: safety pins, needle and thread, extra tights, hair stuff (ties, gel etc.), make-up, band aids, famine hygiene products (if applicable).
- Water is allowed in the building, NO food or gum is allowed in theater.
- Each dancer should bring all costumes and accessories for each dance. Tap shoes that do not lace up should have black elastic (no ribbons).
- Puget Sound Video will video the performance. Please sign up at the flower table to order your DVD/blue ray. Live stream recording will be available.
- NO flash photography or video may be taken at any time during the show. Our house manager will ask you to stop.
- Island Dance Performing Group (Disney Dancers) will be hosting our concessions table this year. Proceeds will go to help offset the cost of dancing in the Disney Parade.
- Students need to remain in their assigned dressing rooms at the theater. If a parents needs to leave with their child, please check in with the assigned room parent prior to leaving, so we can go through the appropriate check out procedures.
- Please call or email us with any questions.
